## MORTON STANLEY PARK TO NORGROVE COURT

Morton Stanley Park is signposted off Windmill Drive and can be approached from either Crabbs Cross or Webheath.

When you turn into the car park, you will see a hard surface path off to the left with a barrier indicating that it is for walkers only. From the main path, take the first turning on the left and, with the woods on your left, keep on the path until you reach turnings to left and right.

At this point, proceed on up the hill following the sign marked 'Nature Trail'. Ignore the stile to your left, but climb the stile in front of you, turn right and over yet another stile. You now descend eleven steps and enter, off to your left, the recently made 'Woodland Walk'.

Follow this delightful path until you reach the new playing fields, then turn left and climb the stile to your right into Green Lane. From this point the going becomes increasingly rural!

A short distance along the lane, take the turning off to the left. Having turned off Green Lane, continue to the signpost which indicates your route along a field path. After the third stile, the path swings off to the left towards the stream. With the broook to your left, keep on until you reach a footbridge.

Crossing the bridge, proceed up the field and come out into the lane between Callow Hill and Elcocks Brook.

Turn right along the lane and you will see the Brook Inn, just before reaching it you will see a lane signposted to Webheath.Follow this road until you reach the entrance to Norgrove Court. On the bend in the lane, proceed to your left, through the gates, over the cattle grid and along the drive. Norgrove Court is visible and, to complete a beautiful scene, there is a lake to your left.

Your way is along the drive and through the second gate on the right. Straight across the field, with a clump of four trees to your left, you come to a stile. Almost immediately you come to a second stile and, having climbed it you come out on to a lane.

Opposite, there is a signpost indicating the way to take. From the lane, follow the hedge on your right down the field until you reach the stream by proceeding to your right through an open gateway and then immediately turning left. Over the path by the stile by the stream, follow this path until you reach a second stile.

When you have climbed over you will recognise the bridge you used earlier in the walk. Keep on until you reach the first stile of the outward journey and then turn right and right again into Green Lane. The stile into the 'Woodland Walk' is on the left and you are back in Morton Stanley Park.
